- ♦ 750 people every week use the current Methodist Church building as a meeting place, out of a village population of around 10,000
- 20 plus different Church Sponsored groups meet regularly, including:
- Community Café, Food for Thought—the Soup Lunch, Little Angels—the Parent, Carer and Toddler group, Fellowship and Friendship groups for women and men of all ages and stages, the Youth Group including a base for Duke of Edinburgh activities, and many more
- We host many other community led groups, including the Radcliffe Male Voice Choir, and other interest groups, exercise and dance classes for children and adults, the very popular Friday Night Youth Project, and more
- Community groups of all kinds, looking for a meeting place, are regularly told there is 'no room at the inn' and need to look elsewhere
- As soon as the new building is complete, there will be room for double the groups and people.

Not only do we now have Planning
Permission granted, but we have been
successful in our appeal against some of the
restrictions that were put in place. These
could have limited our ability to meet all the
needs of the people who will use the new
meeting place.
