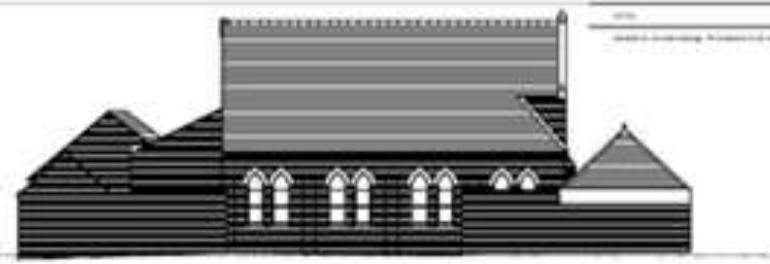


Existing South West Elevation - 1/100



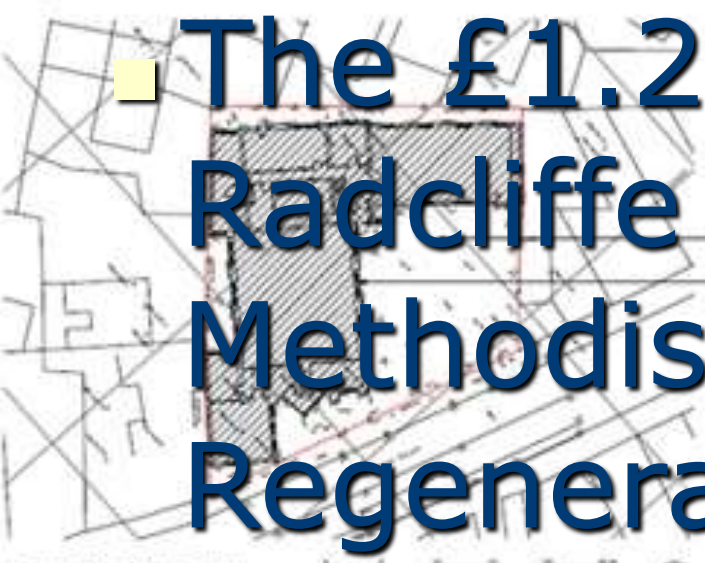
Existing North East Elevation - 1/100



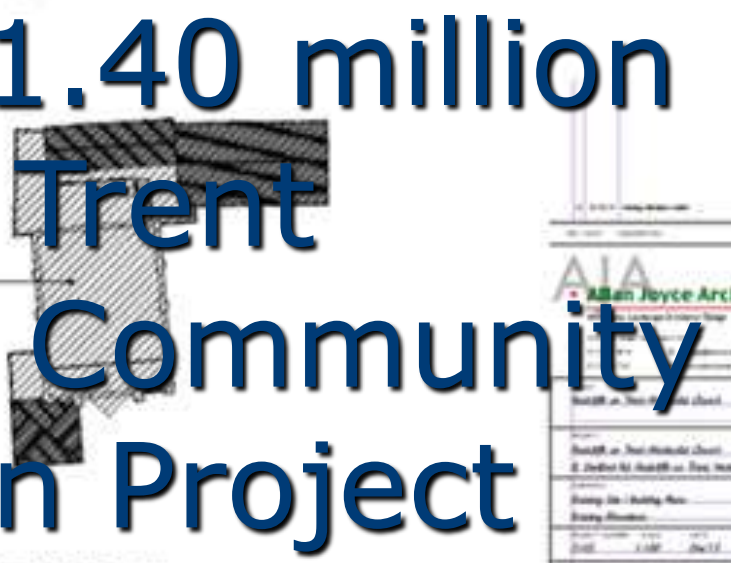
Existing North West Elevation - 1/100







The current buildings are inefficient to heat, have multiple levels which constitute trip hazards and have too few rooms to locate the potential users from church and community.



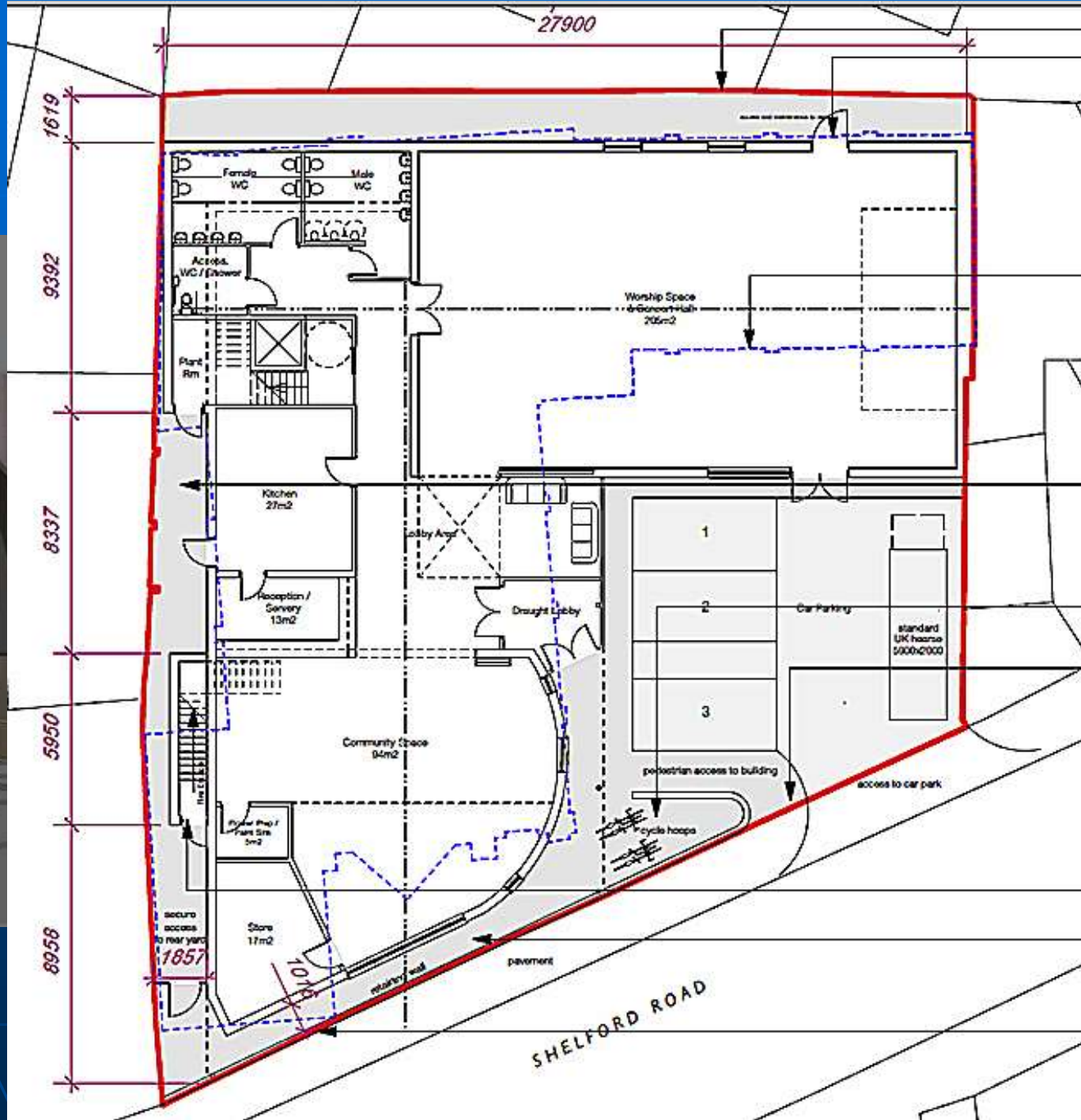
The proposed building will allow greater interaction with the community with increased opportunity for our Village community.



The options for refurbishment, relocation, and rebuild have all been considered, refurbishment still leaves us with many of our present problems and the only available alternative sites are much further from the village centre.

The proposal is for a modern, steel framed structure. It has two storeys on the old church outline and a single storey section, housing the new multi-purpose worship and performance space on the site of the current schoolroom building.

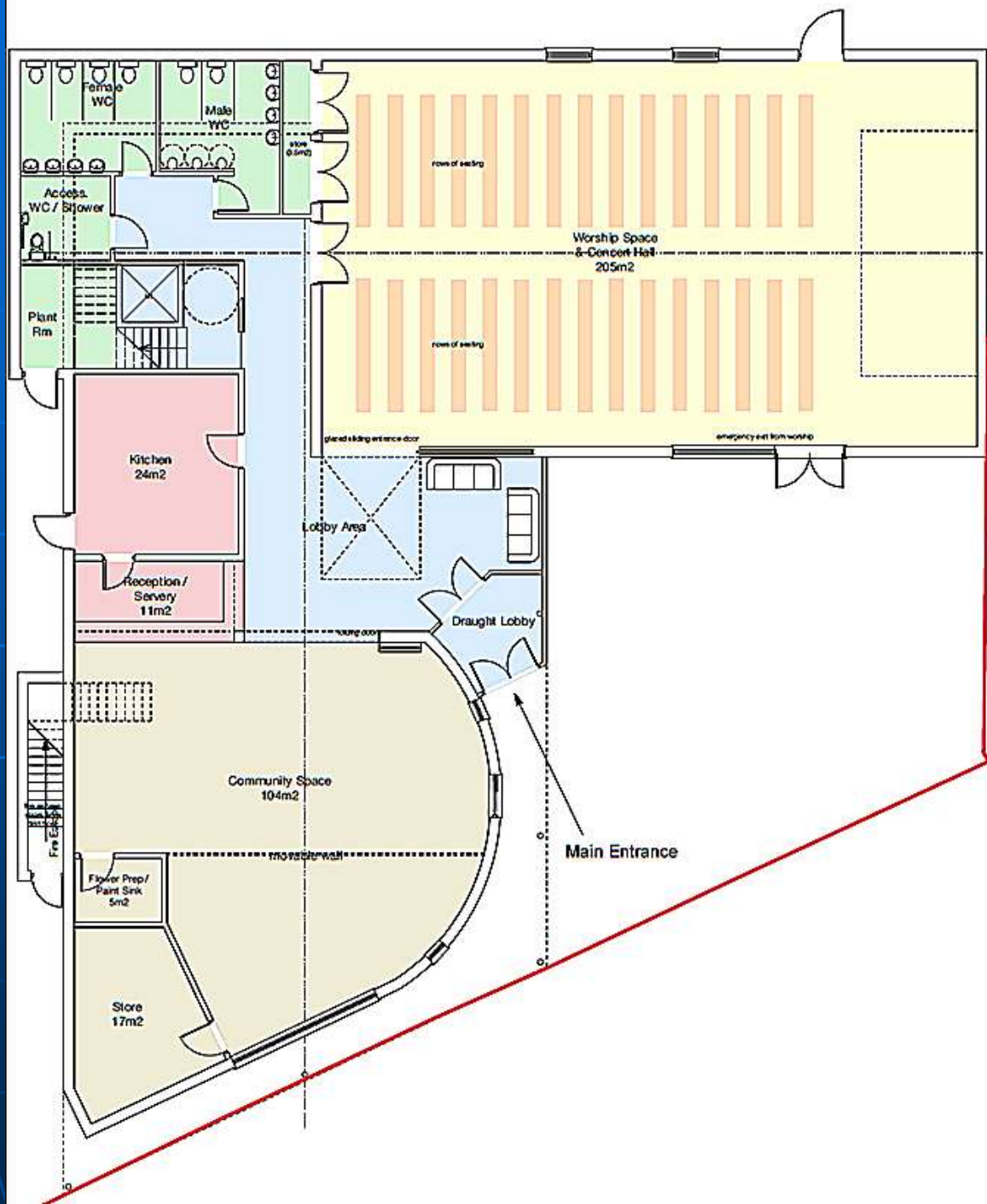

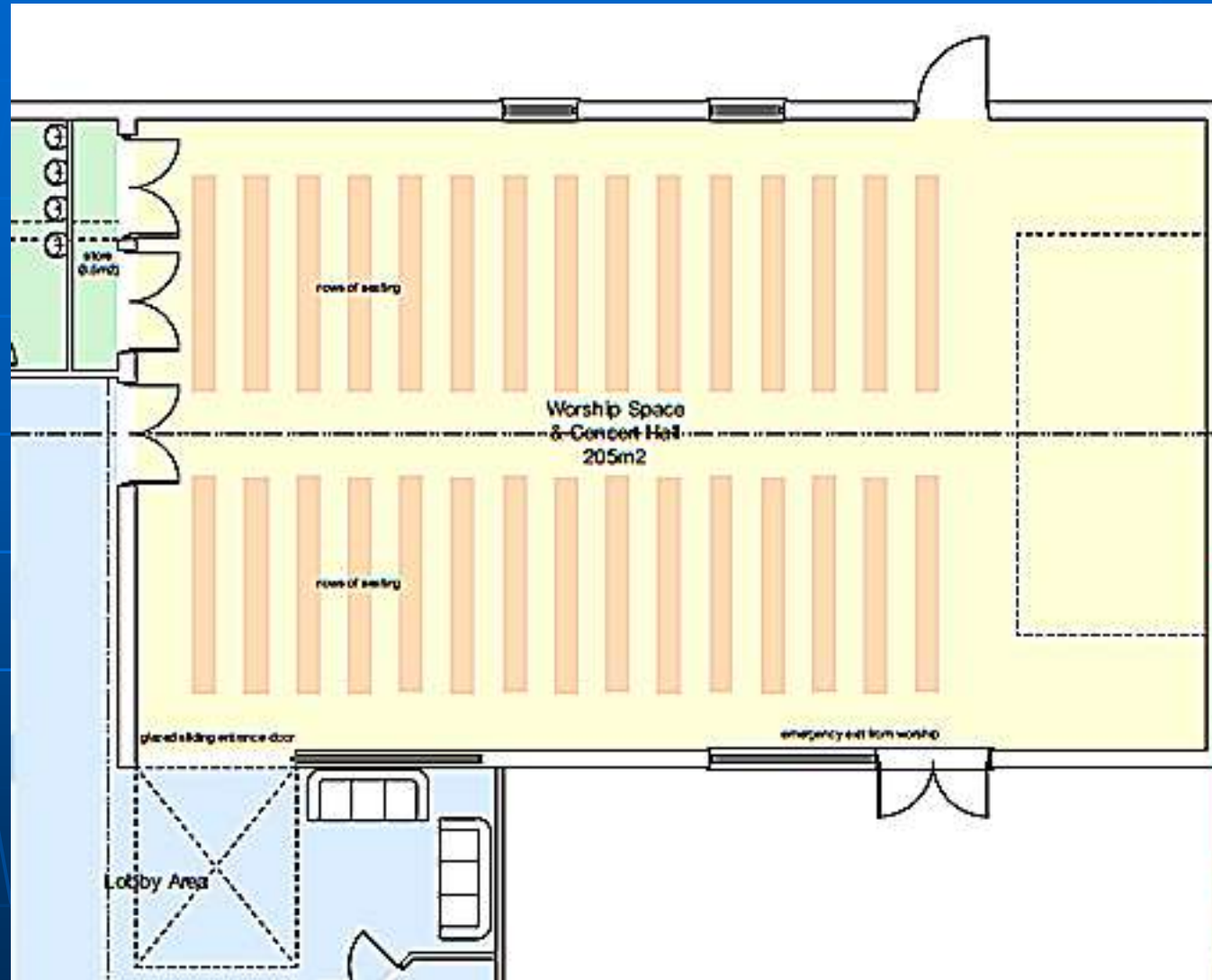

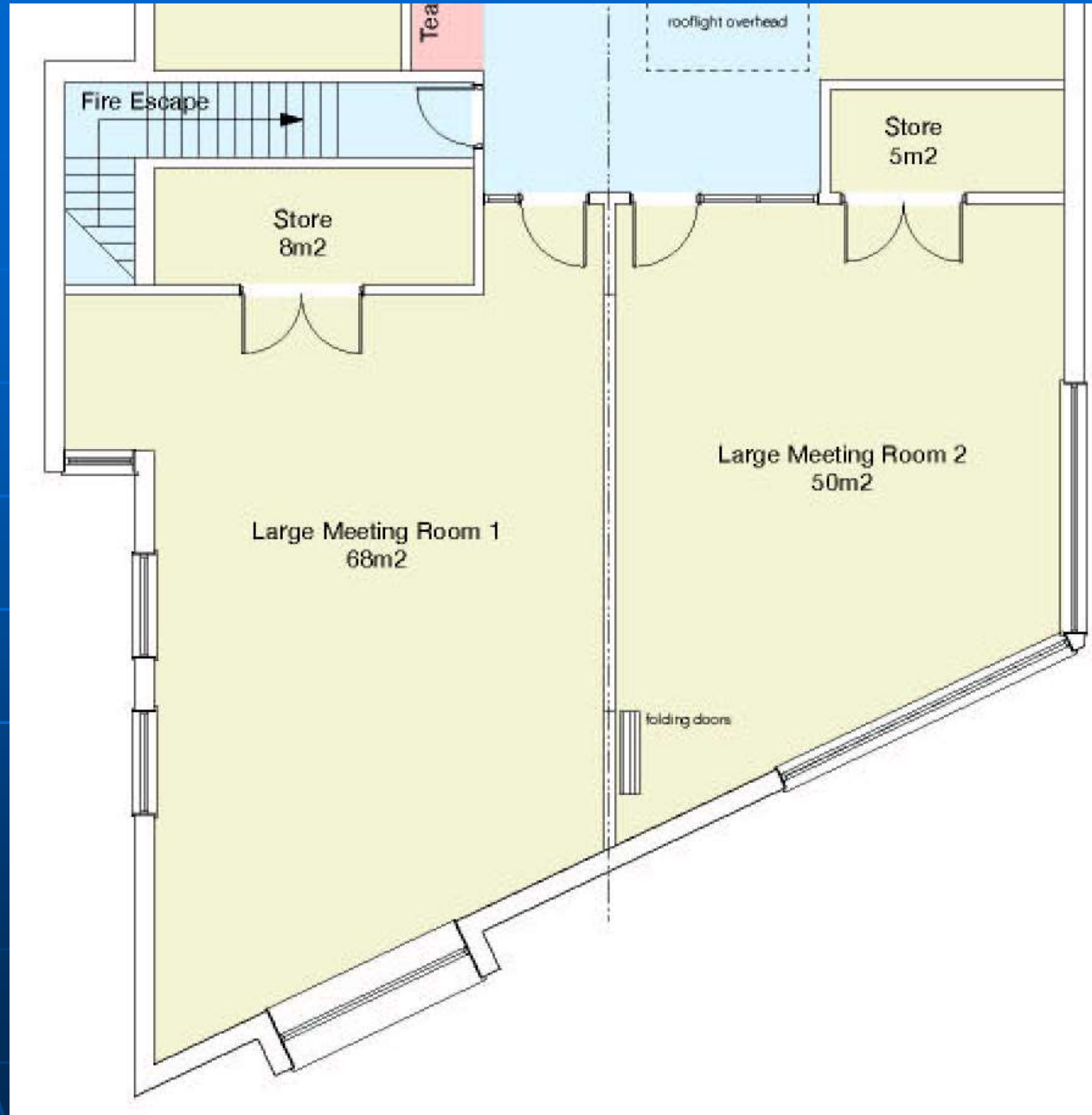
